# The CleanScapes Program: Become Part of the Stormwater Solution



Stormwater runoff from impervious surfaces is responsible for a significant amount of pollution entering our local waterways, and impairing water quality in the Chesapeake Bay.

As a Howard County resident, you can be part of the stormwater solution by increasing the number of surfaces on your property that

capture runoff from impervious surfaces. In addition to protecting the environment, you'll also have the opportunity to reduce your Watershed Protection Fee and be reimbursed for your projects.

#### **About CleanScapes**

- The reimbursement is a one-time payment towards the cost of installing a clean scape practice.
- Credit is an annual percentage (based upon the impervious that has been treated by your practice) towards your Watershed Protection Fee.
- There are eight different CleanScapes Best
   Management Practices (BMP's) to choose from,
   and all have minimum requirements that must be
   met to be eligible for reimbursement and credit.
